CONDITIONS OF ENTRY IRISH OPEN VETERANS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017

- 1. The Championship is sanctioned by, and will be conducted under the Laws, Rules and Regulations of Tennis Ireland. The Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced.
- 2. Entries close at 6.00p.m. on Monday 22nd May, 2017, but the Committee reserves the right to accept later entries in special circumstances. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. No withdrawals will be accepted after 9a.m. on Wednesday 24th May 2017.
- 3. The draws will take place on Friday 26th May, 2017, or at such later times as may be notified by notice posted in the Clubhouse of Templeogue Tennis Club.
- 4. Entries are confined to members of recognised Clubs, and other players approved by the Committee, not being persons excluded from competing in Tournament by the Rules of Tennis Ireland. All players must be registered and have a valid Tennis Ireland pin. To register go to http://ti.tournamentsoftware.com.
- 5. Events will be seeded.
- 6. **Competitors may only enter two events.** (Excluding the Mixed Doubles Event see condition 9)
- 7. **Singles events**: Players may only enter 1 singles event and it must be in their own age category; Subject to rule 13.
- 8. **Doubles events**: Players may enter 2 doubles events where they are not playing a singles event. The younger player determines the age category that must be entered.
- 9. A special **Mixed Doubles** event will be played over Sunday and Monday for all first round losers that wish to enter. There will be **NO ENTRY FEE** for this event. To be eligible a player must be a first round loser in <u>all</u> other events entered. The tournament office will enter you into the draw for this event and match you with a partner, if you elect to play and are eligible.
- 10. Where a qualifying age is specified, players must attain that age not later than 31st December, 2017.
- 11. Play will not commence before 5.00p.m. Thursday 1st June 2017. Play will commence at 9.00a.m. each succeeding day, or at such times as the Referee may require. Competitors not present when called upon to play may be disqualified. It is the duty of the Competitors to acquaint themselves with the times at which they are to play. Draws and schedule will be available via the Tennis Ireland App or on our website; reference http://ti.tournamentsoftware.com.
- 12. Competitors from outside Leinster will not be required to play before 1p.m. Friday 2nd June 2017.
- 13. Should an event have less than 8 entries, players may be asked to play in a lower age group.
- 14. Entries with limited availability may not be accepted.
- 15. Some finals may be played on Sunday 4th June 2017, however the majority of finals will be played on Monday 5th June 2017. Prize giving will take place on the same day as the final.
- 16. Tennis balls sanctioned by Tennis Ireland will be used.
- 17. Competitors must wear white tennis tops with either white, navy or black skirts/shorts.
- 18. The tie-break will apply at 6 games all in the first two sets followed by the championship tie-break if applicable (1st to 10, win by two points).
- 19. All weather courts will be available for play. Outside all weather/hard courts will be used if necessary.
- 20. All players must check in 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the match.
- 21. The committee reserves the right of adding to, or altering, the above conditions, and of refusing any entry, without stating its reasons.
- 22. No complaint in connection with the conduct of the Tournament can be processed, unless it is made in accordance with 3.1.10.1 of the Regulations for Conduct of official Tournaments, approved by Tennis Ireland.
